

7.1.1 Measures initiated by the Institution for the promotion of gender equity during the year 2023.

Appasaheb Birnale College of Architecture (ABCA), Sangli, has been proactive in promoting gender equity and ensuring the safety and well-being of all its students, particularly women, throughout 2023. The institution has taken several key measures, including awareness campaigns, events, and the provision of gender-sensitive facilities, to foster an inclusive and safe campus environment.

Measures for Promoting Gender Equity in 2023-24

One of the key initiatives was the **Anti-Ragging Week** celebrated from **12th August 2023 to 18th August 2023**, which aimed to create a safe, supportive, and non-discriminatory atmosphere for students, irrespective of gender. During this week, the college organised several competitions to engage students and raise awareness about the harmful effects of ragging and the importance of mutual respect. These included a **Slogan and Logo Design Competition**, **Poster Making Competition**, and an **Essay Writing Competition** on the topic of anti-ragging. These activities were designed not only to promote a culture of respect and equality but also to highlight the significance of gender sensitivity in preventing ragging, especially towards female students.

Further promoting gender equity, the Women's Day celebration on 15th March 2024 featured prominent guest speakers, including Dr. Aparna Dixit and Ar. Nandini Deshpande, who shared their experiences and insights on women's empowerment, leadership, and overcoming gender biases in architecture and related fields. Their talks emphasised the importance of women breaking barriers and excelling in traditionally male-dominated professions, reinforcing the institution's commitment to creating an inclusive, gender-neutral space for learning and professional growth.


